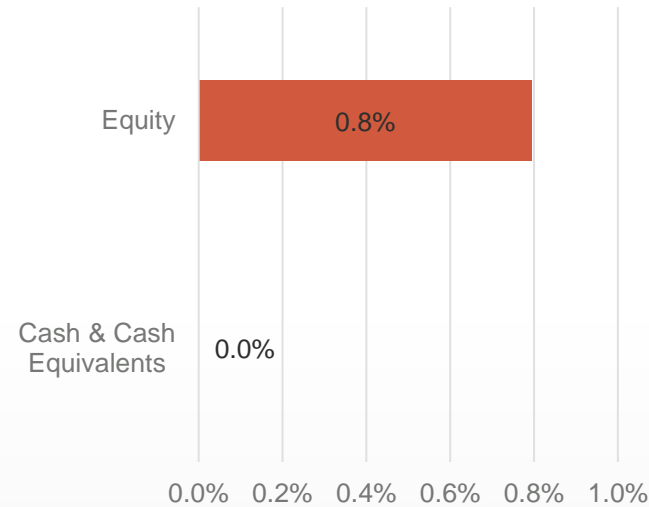

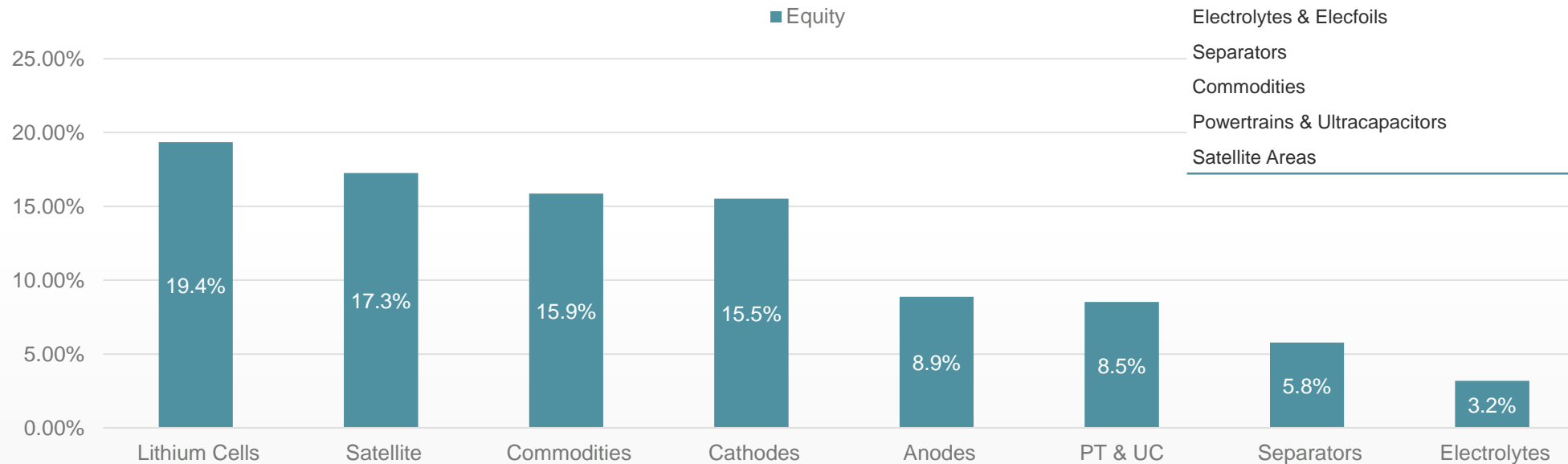

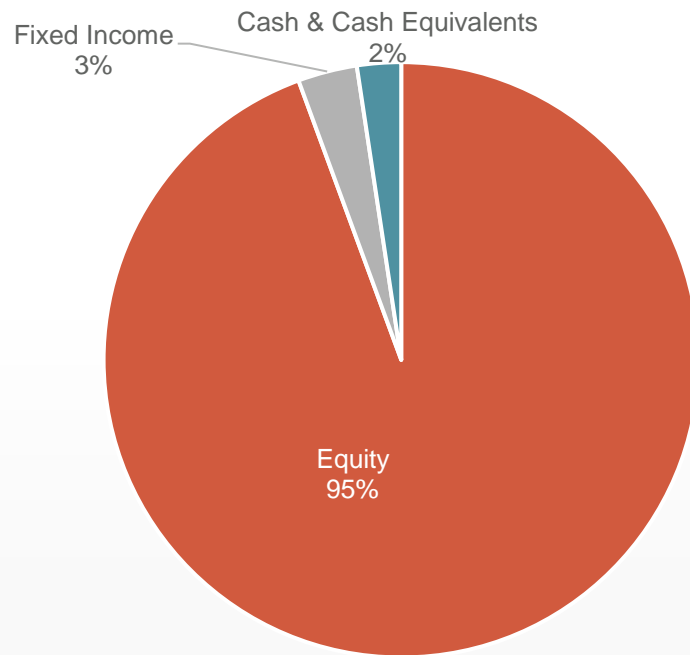

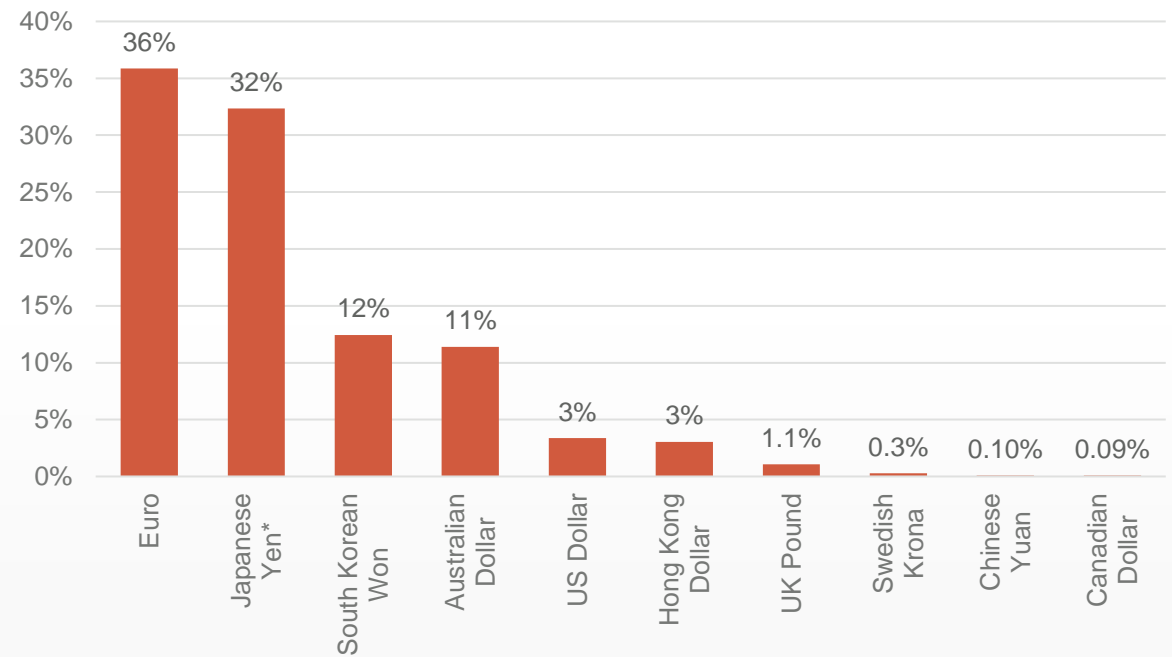

as of 31 July '21**

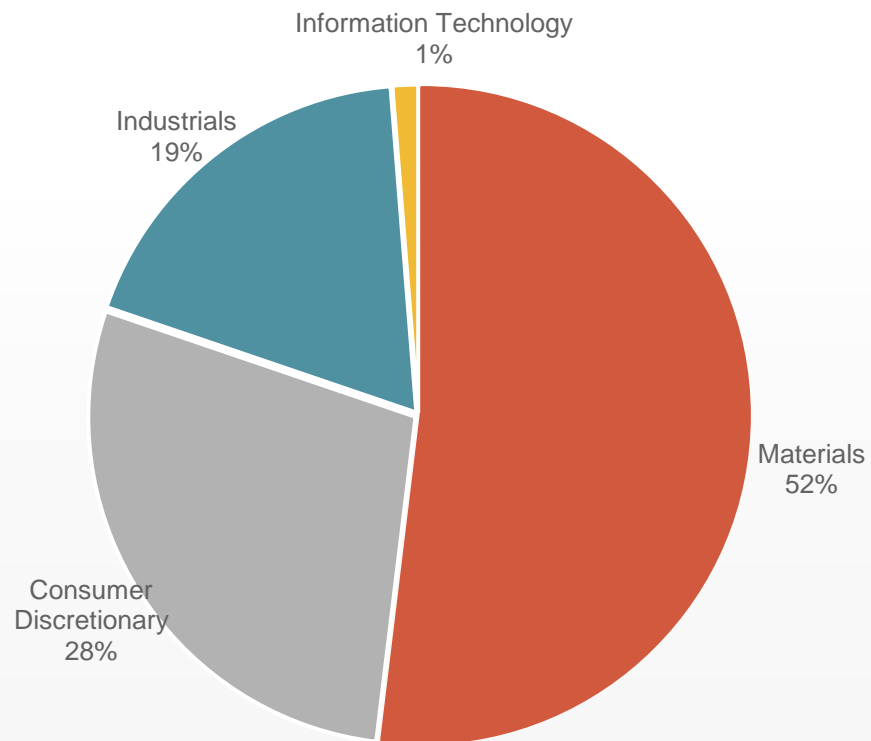

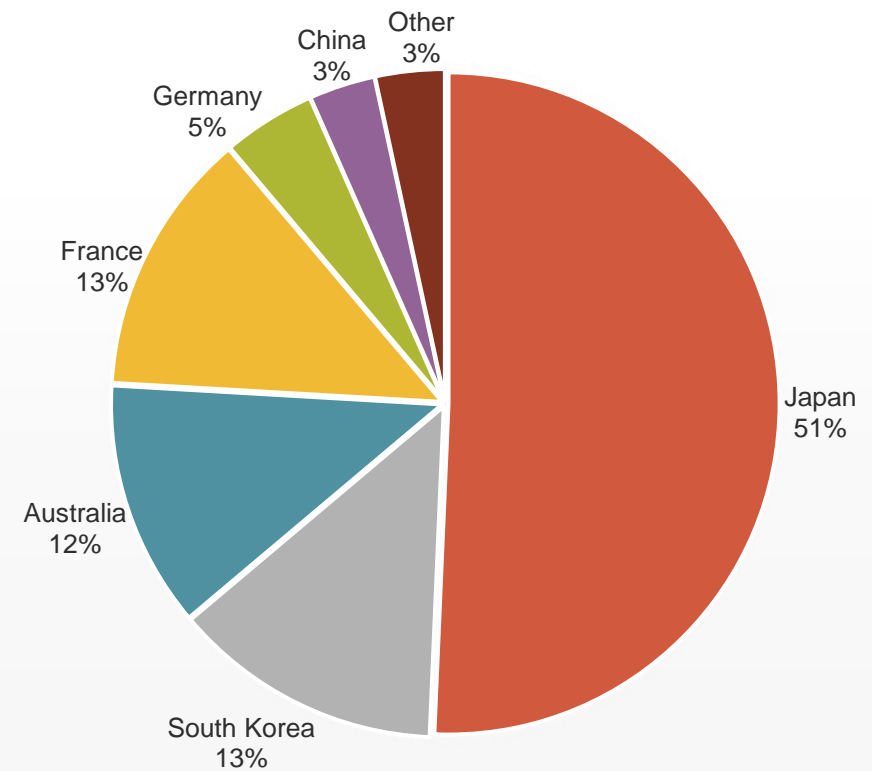

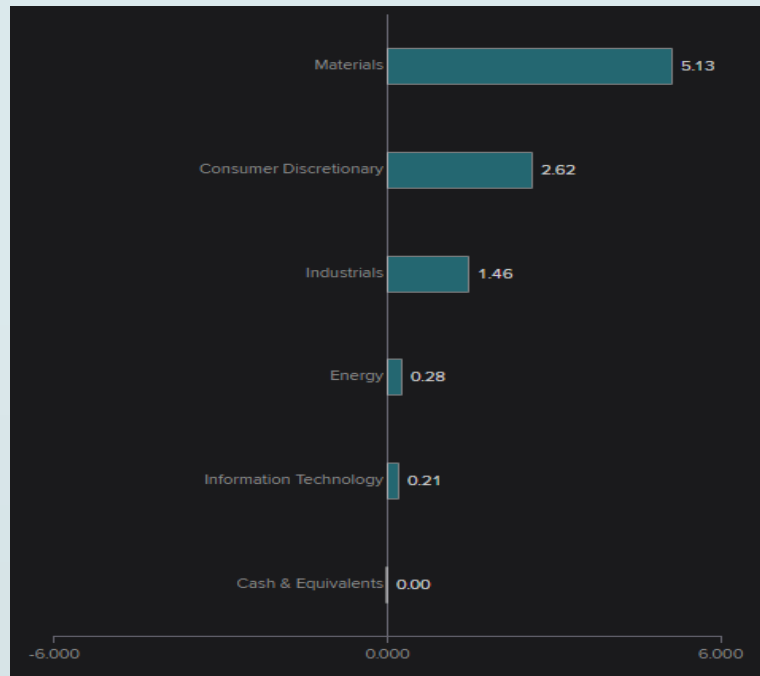

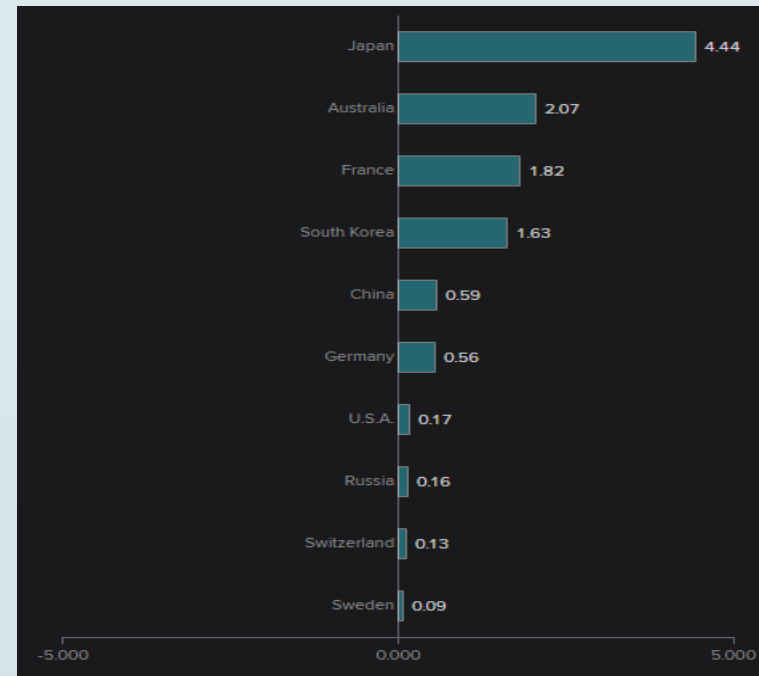

AS OF 31/07/2021**



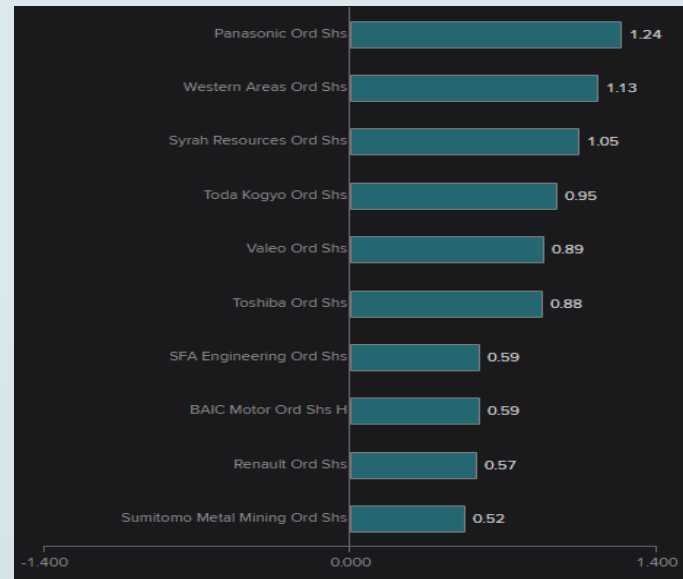
**VAR 1M – 95% BY COUNTRY
AS OF 31/07/2021**



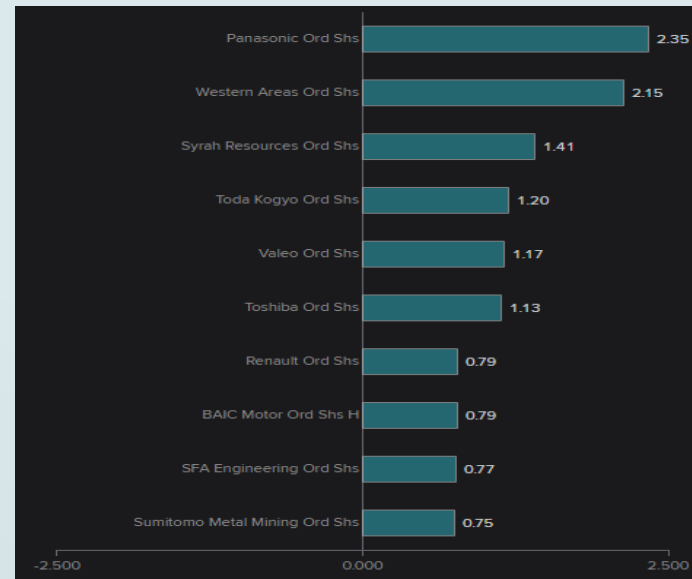

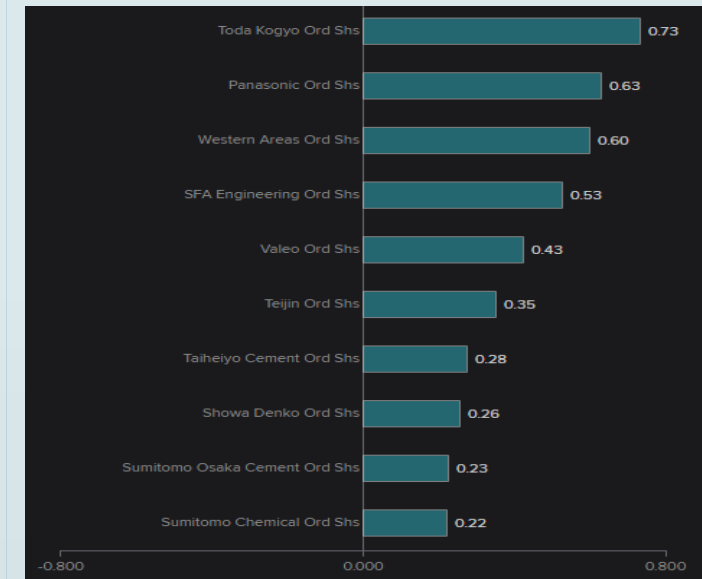
**VAR 1M-95% TOP 10 SECURITIES

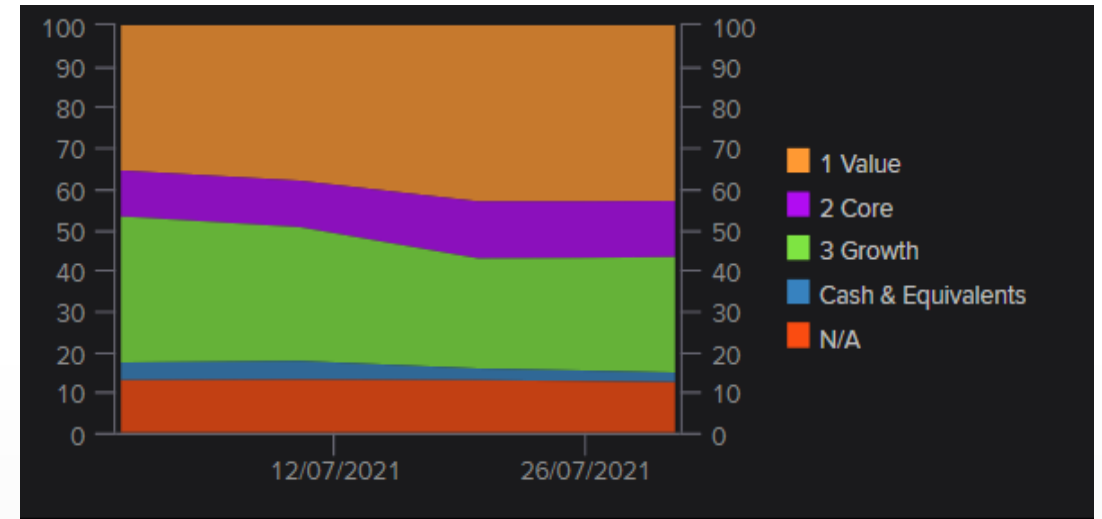
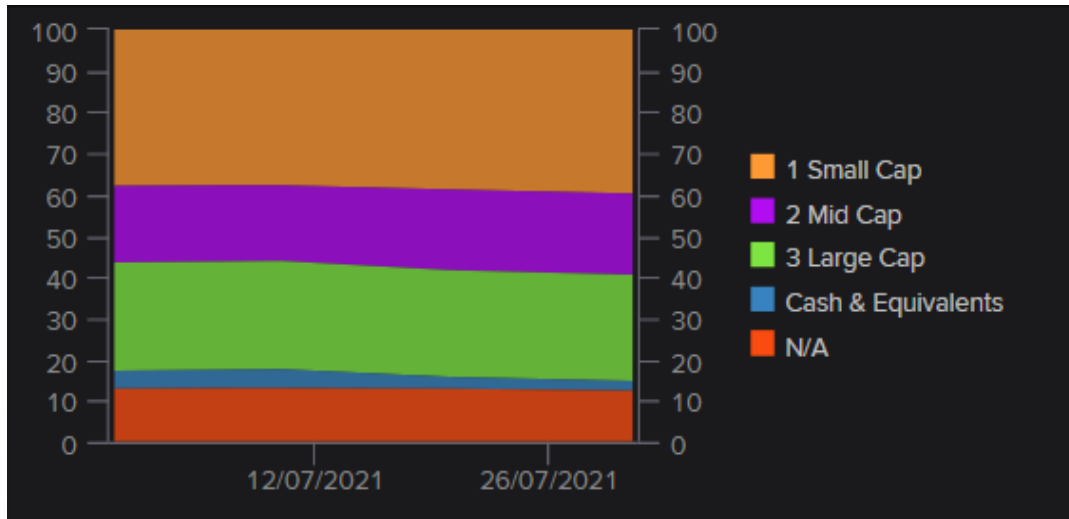
